Drama	Consumable products eg. Makeup & supplies.
Food Technologies	Ingredients for practical lessons.
Industrial Technology Metal	Materials required for in class and individual projects.
Industrial Technology Woodwork	Wood, plywood, MDF & particle board, abrasive materials, clock mechanisms, welding rods & wire, steel, brass gas equipment, paint, rivets, bolts screws etc.

Textiles & Design	Basic class materials – threads, bobbins, needles, tape measures etc.
Visual Arts	Paper/drawing media, clays, glazes & brushes, paints, canvas, boards, etc.
