SUBJECT	DESCRIPTION
School Contribution	Provides textbooks - including novels, plays, poetry collections. Classroom consumables for computers, art supplies, stationery. Extra sport equipment. Long term projects e.g. undercover areas for students.
Galston High School Public Library	Library books & equipment (tax deductible).
P&C Contribution to School maintenance	Garden and lawn maintenance and long-term projects e.g. fencing and landscaping.
Technology Upgrade Contribution	Support school computer network and upgrades.
Agriculture	 Provision of seedlings for the growing of vegetables and other crops by students. Feed for animals used in the teaching of the practical aspects of the agricultural course. Medication needed for maintaining the health of the animals. Resources required for the control of pests and diseases in students plots or experimental areas.
Drama	Consumable products eg. Makeup & supplies.
Food Technologies	Ingredients for practical lessons.
Industrial Technology Metal	Materials required for in class and individual projects.
Industrial Technology Woodwork	Wood, plywood, MDF & particle board, abrasive materials, paint etc.
Photography & Digital Media	All materials – display book, visual arts diary, film, paper, SD memory card for still & video cameras, camera maintenance & high-resolution colour printing.

Textiles & Design	Basic class materials – threads, bobbins, needles, tape measures etc.
